Notice inviting Expression of Interest for framing Recruitment Rules including promotion rules and Service Rules

Regional Cancer Centre (RCC), Thiruvananthapuram is a Society registered in the year 1981 under the Travancore Cochin Literary, Scientific & Charitable Societies Registration Act 1955. RCC is fully owned by the State Government of Kerala. Management of the Centre is vested in the Governing Body chaired by the Hon'ble Chief Minister and Executive Committee chaired by the Secretary to Government (Health), Government of Kerala. Director, who is appointed by the State Government, is the Chief Executive of RCC.

Regional Cancer Centre is a comprehensive Cancer Centre which is established with the following objectives:

- Deliver State-of-the-art cancer care at affordable cost.
- Create cancer awareness among public and health professionals.
- Generate trained manpower in cancer control.
- Organize outreach programmes in cancer control.
- Conduct focused cancer research relevant to the society.
- Lead cancer control activities in the State.

Currently, RCC has 26 speciality departments and 844 regular staff in different categories in the academic, administrative, auxiliary, technical, nursing, clinical, paramedical services etc.

Almost all categories of posts in the Centre carries Central Government Scales of Pay (Pay Band plus Grade Pay/Academic Grade Pay) and promotional avenues as available to the identical categories in the Sree Chitra Thirunal Institute for Medical Sciences & Technology (SCTIMST), Thiruvananthapuram.

The management of the Society has decided to frame comprehensive recruitment rules, service rules, conduct rules and disciplinary rules for the various categories of staff of the Centre.

For the purpose it has been decided to engage the services of a person(s)/firm who shall be present on all working days in the Office of Regional Cancer Centre for a period of 3 months within which he/they should submit the draft rules.

Expression of Interest with detailed terms and conditions are invited from competent persons/ consultants/ retired State or Central Government Officials equivalent or above the rank of Deputy Secretary/ Deputy Director of State Government who have prior experience in this particular field of framing draft rules as mentioned above. Out of the total (Service Charges) consideration amount, 50% shall be paid on submission of the final draft rules to RCC and the balance shall be paid after obtaining from Government the approval of the draft rules. Last date for receipt of the Expression of Interest by the undersigned is 4 pm on 10-01-2019.
